In his 1964 book Charlie and the Chocolate Factory Roald Dahl depicts the iconic Oompa-Loompas as African Pygmy people Yet, in 1971 Mel Stuart's "I'm Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory the Oompa-Loompas are portrayed as little people with orange skin and green hair In Dahl's 1973 revision of this text he depicts the Oompa-Loompas as white
